Behavioural economics is a growing and vibrant theoretical and empirical field of interdisciplinary nature, bringing together economics, sociology, anthropology and psychology. Similarly, scholars of behavioural economics have seldom looked into distant historical periods in their research. This workshop aims to initiate such a dialogue, with a particular attention for the possibilities of adaptation and cross-fertilization of theories and methods across disciplines and historical periods.
